

- 1. **Insert Batteries:** Unscrew the battery cover and insert 2 AAA (1.5V alkaline) batteries as shown in Figure 1. Replace the cover and silicone seal.
- 2. Connect USB Dongle: Start your PC and insert the USB dongle into a free USB port.
- 3. **Plug-and-Play:** It may take a few minutes for the drivers to install automatically. No additional drivers are required.
- 4. **Battery Check:** Press left and right buttons and check the LED on the bottom: **Green:** Battery OK. **Red:** Replace batteries.

Touch Scroll Sensor

Swipe your finger forward or backward over the touch sensor located between the left and right buttons to scroll. Double-tap the touch sensor to simulate a middle button function.

Cleaning Instructions

The silicone cover is designed for quick and thorough cleaning with hospital-grade disinfectants, including 70% alcohol.

1. Activate cleaning mode:

 Press and hold the left and right buttons for 10 seconds to enter cleaning mode (blinking green light). The mouse is now disabled to prevent unintended inputs.

2. Clean the mouse:

Use your preferred disinfectant solution to clean the surface.

3. Reactivate the mouse:

 Press and hold left and right buttons for 4 seconds to exit cleaning mode. The mouse is now ready for use.
